They looked at each other and laughed, then turned and walked out. They burned the cotton gin, the barn and took the horse and buggy. But she saved the bale of cotton.

After the war and after her husband's death she made her home with Aunt Letha Creech Hartzog and her husband Bill. She drew a widow's pension of \$25.00 a month. Uncle Bill Hartzog signed for it each month.
